Justification:

TCEQ has concerns regarding the validity of metals-in-water data collected using water sampling kits from Albion Environmental Lab. During 2008-2009 contract period, TCEQ is offering to supply the sampling kits and analyze the water samples at their Houston Lab. NRA will conduct the metals-in-water sampling under the SWQM QAPP.

Summary of Changes:

The Coordinated Monitoring Schedule has been revised to reflect changes related to metals-in-water sampling at five locations.

Detail of Changes:

Segment 2103, Station 17648: Removed 2 metals-in-water.

Segment 2106, Station 12977: Removed 2 metals-in-water.

Segment 2483A, Station 18848: Removed 2 metals-in-water.

The updated Coordinated Monitoring Schedule for Basins 21 and 24 are attached.
